1. The documents that are not in Korean or English must be translated to Korean or English and the copy must be submitted with certification from a notary. Documents and Certificates from school abroad should be submitted with an Apostille affixed. Nationals of countries that have not signed the Apostille treaty must get verification from the local Korean consulate.

2. Transfer applicants should submit the Master's (Doctorate's) official transcript.

3. Applicants who have Korean or English language test scores for one of the following tests should submit their scores. Applicants must meet the following minimum required scores :

TOPIK level 3 or higher TOEFL PBT 530, CBT 197, IBT 71, IELTS 5.5, TEPS 600, MATE-Speaking CL/Writing MH(or higher).

Alternatively, applicants with other internationally authorized English test score may submit those scores. (English test scores are only accepted for students with majors whose classes are all taught in English.)

* Accepted students who have registered and do not have any Korean or English language scores must take a Language Proficiency Exam before the semester starts. If the results are lower than the requirement, a leave of absence should be taken until an acceptable score is obtained.

Exception

(1) Korean or other national Government Scholarship students will follow the regulation provided by the appropriate government.

(2) Applicants in the arts and physical education : TOPIK level 2 or higher

(3) Applicants who meet one of the following condition below exempt from submitting language test score.

- Applicants who received a BA or MA degree in Korea
- Applicants who graduated with a major in Korean language
- Applicants who have finished their Korean Language Courses level 4 or higher at LinguaExpress Applicants from Countries with English as Official Language : Only accepted for students with majors whose classes are all taught in English

If you completed your education entirely in English, and in a country where English is considered an official language, you may submit a written appeal with your application explaining why you qualify for an English Test score waiver. Appeals will be reviewed after all application items have been received.


X Accepted international students should obtain TOPIK level 4 or higher to graduate from SMU.

1. Entrance Scholarships (1st Semester)

• Evaluation criteria : GPA(grade point average), Interview Score, TOPIK score

(1) No need to apply for the 1st Semester Scholarship.

(2)The Scholarship result will be announced on the website(<u>http://e.sookmyung.ac.kr</u>) with the final result announcement.

(3) Amount of entrance fee and tuition will be given according to the standard of applying semester and major.

(4) The number of Scholarship students will be determined by the Scholarship Committee.

(5) Accommodation fee and airfare, etc. could be additionally supported through the evaluation.

2. Scholarship while in School (2nd Semester-4th Semester: MA/2nd Semester-4th Semester: Ph.D.)

(1) Automatically awarded based on previous semester's GPA

(2) According to the International Students Admission regulations, the scholarship could be changed

(3) One must be taking more than 6 credits excluding Pass/Fail courses

(4) Only given to regular semester (Receiving semester basis: 4 semesters for Master, 4 semesters for Ph.D.)

(5) The GPA of Supplementary Course during MA or Ph.D will not be included at total GPA.

3. Outstanding Korean Scholarship while in School

(1) Eligibility : One must be from a low- and lower-middle-income countries and have a TOPIK score

- Undergraduate Program : TOPIK level 4 or higher
- Graduate Program : : TOPIK level 5 or higher
- (2) Necessary Document : A copy of Valid TOPIK score

(3) Period of Support : Once in a year
